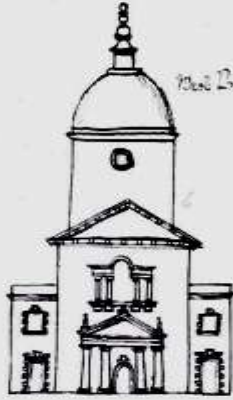

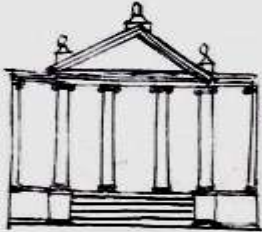

Cathedral of Landaff.

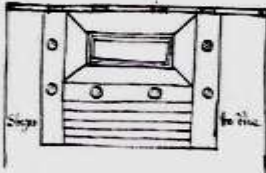


West Prospect of Landaff Church.

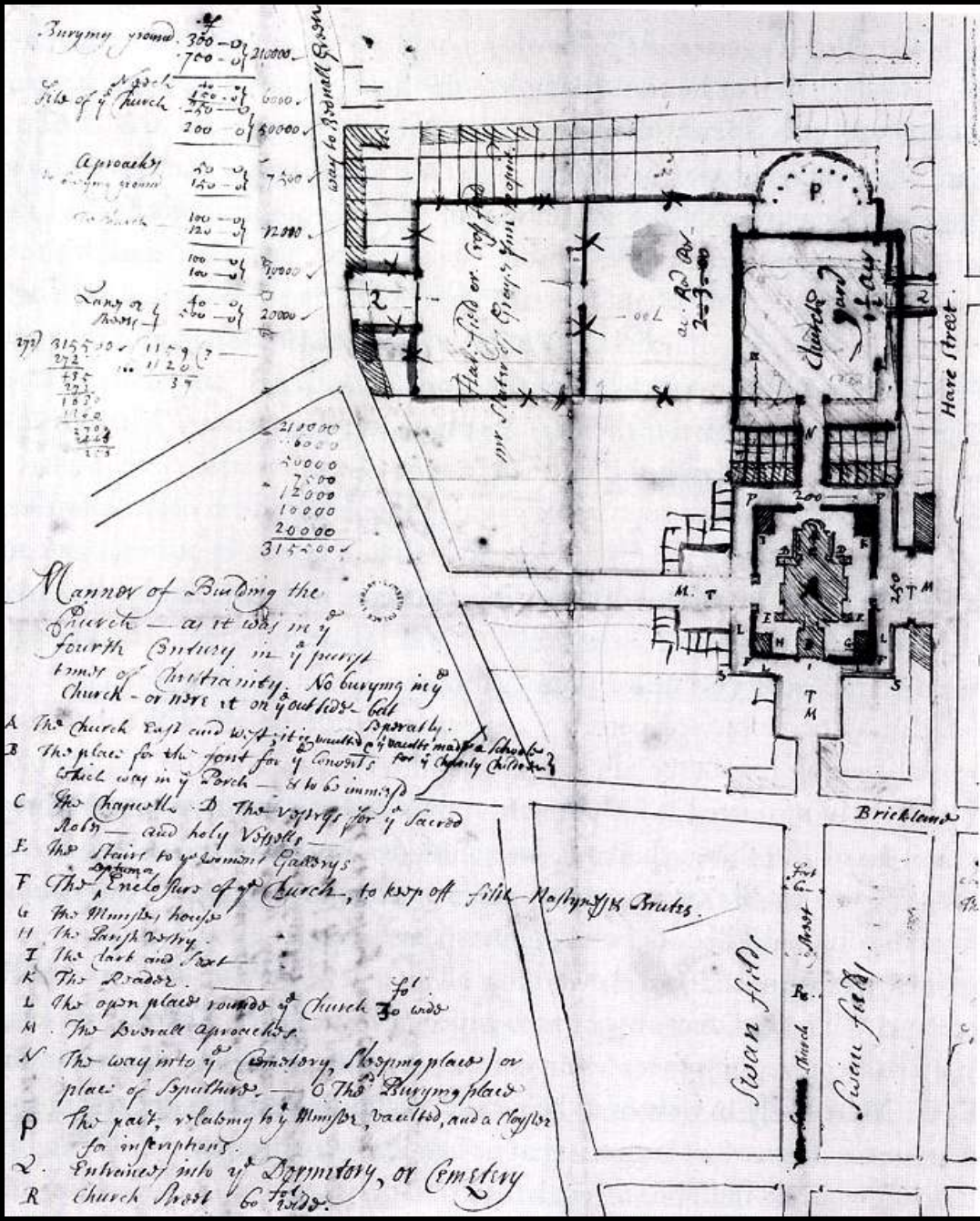


South Prospect of the Cathedral Church of Landaff, as intended to be repaired or new built. 1736.

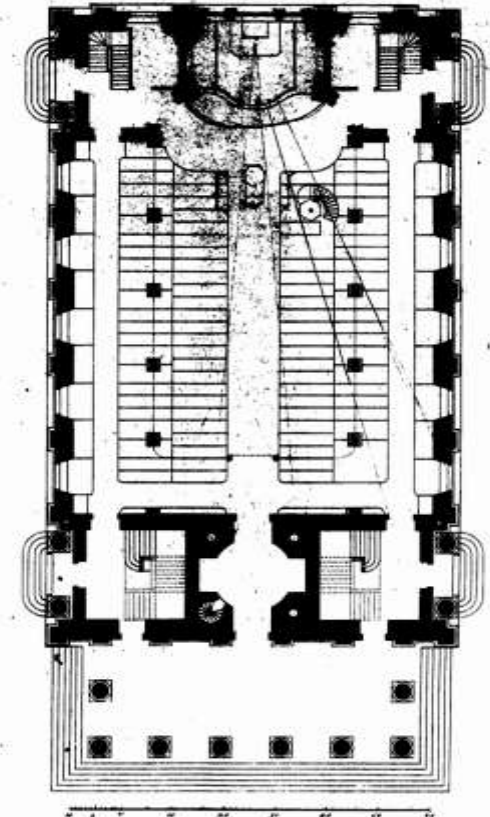

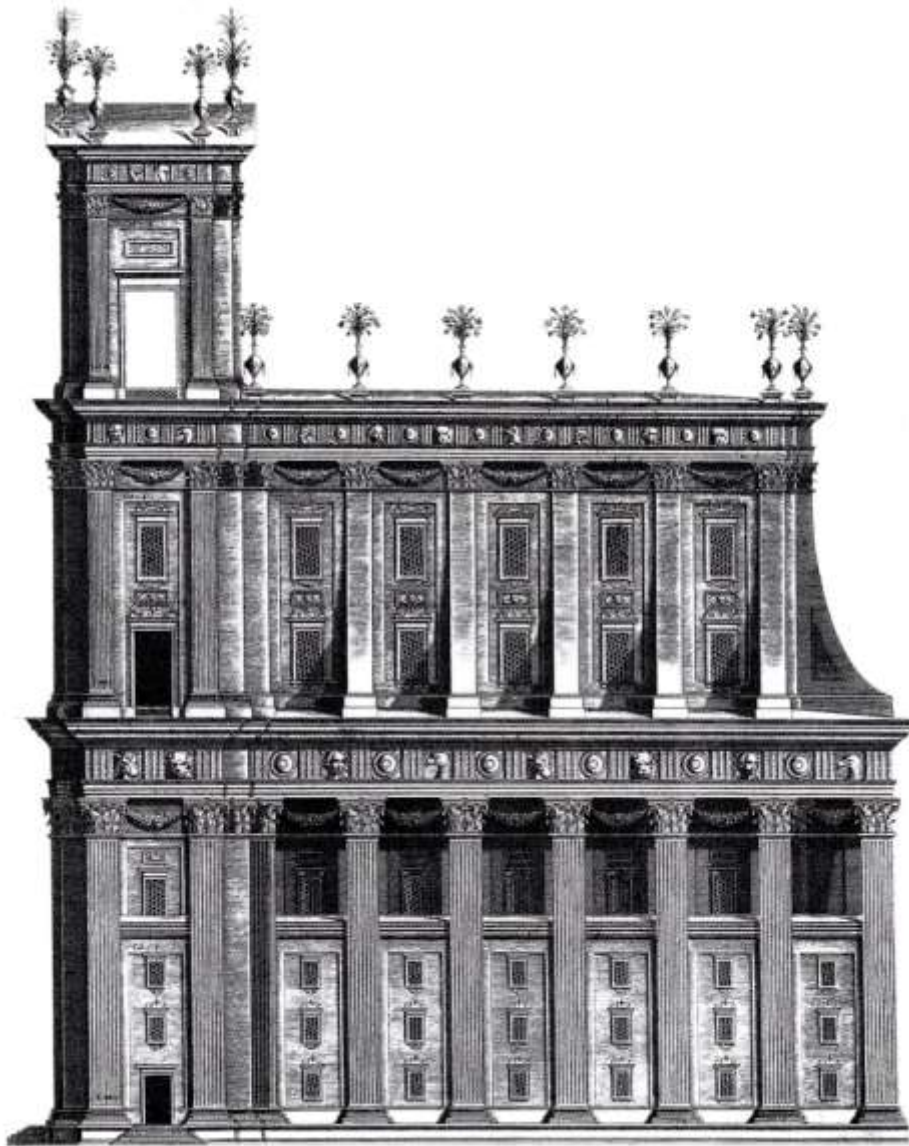
The North Side of St. Martin's Church
